- Home team is determined by a flip of the coin throughout the tournament.

- Next inning begins when 3rd out is made in the previous inning.

- 90 minutes Drop Dead Time. 120 minutes Drop Dead on Semi Finals and Finals unless tied.

- at the 90 minute mark, score will revert to the last completed inning.

- teams will have 2 minutes to get their teams on the field. Umpire may begin pitching at the two minute mark.

- NO WARMUPS, Warm ups between innings will not be allowed.

- Suggest you get your players to the games early to warmup because warmups during the game will not be allowed.

- If a team is deemed to be stalling the umpire may declare it at the time of the offense and allow for extra time to finish the game.

- Since this is a judgement call this cannot be contested or argued.

Only a coach shall talk to an umpire about this issue.

-Fair Play Rule is in affect.

-Machine Pitch only, no player pitch

-5 pitches off machine, unlimited foul balls on last pitch

-Players must bring ball inside the baseline to call time.

-5 run maximum per inning. 7 run maximum in the 6th inning and beyond.

Let the player have fun and figure this out.

The Commissioner realizes this is the first competitive ball for some coaches and parents. Please keep it positive and support all players. Remember, they are not robots, they will make mistakes.
